Dear Parent/Carer,

**Thank you for your continued support through what has been a challenging year.** New government announcements have been made over the past few days regarding changes to the way schools can operate from September. We are currently putting all plans in place and hope to have draft arrangements with you by the end of the summer term. **Please keep a close look out for this important information.**

### IMPORTANT END OF TERM UPDATES AND CHANGES

**Many of our families and staff will be celebrating Eid over the days of Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> July and Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> July.** During this time, we want to ensure that every child still receives a high-quality education. To facilitate this on both of these days, learning at Tile Cross and throughout all Secondary Schools within the Washwood Heath Multi Academy Trust is to be delivered remotely online and via printed work packs. This way, absence from school as a result of Eid will not disrupt learning.

**Students last day on school site will be Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July. This day will follow normal school timings and lessons will continue throughout the day. Students on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July will be able to attend school in non-school uniform to celebrate the end of a unique school year.** Non-uniform day allows students the opportunity to express themselves as individuals, but please remember that this must be done in an appropriate way and students must be dressed suitably for school. **To support with our planned activities students must wear trainers or bring their trainers with them.**

**On Friday 16<sup>th</sup> July all students will be sent home with printed work packs to cover these two days of remote learning. Oak National links will also be available via our school website to extend resources further and support students with their learning.** It is expected that students who are not celebrating Eid undertake two days of remote learning and those who are celebrating undertake one day.

As a school we will be in touch before the end of the academic year regarding our initial start of term arrangements for September and more detailed information regarding plans will be released towards the end of the summer holidays.
